Study-Abroad in TAIWAN & CHINA 2016

Program Overview

This study abroad program is designed for the students to explore Chinese culture, ancient Chinese technological inventions, and survey the development and achievement of technology in present-day China and Taiwan as well as its impacts on the society. Students will travel to **Changhua**, **Taichung**, and **Taipei** cities in **Taiwan** and **Beijing** in **China**, for a total of three weeks. Prior to traveling, one-week classes will be held on campus. The program has a **student buddy system** with the host universities, it is a great opportunity for the students to learn / practice Chinese conversation. This year the students will participate in a summer camp,

Technology and Culture in Taiwan - Summer Camp in NCUE.

As the course is taught in English, no prior knowledge of Chinese is required.

General Itinerary*

After flying from Nashville to Taiwan, we will reside in guest housing on the main campus of National Changhua University of Education (NCUE) in Changhua City.

We will join the **Technology and Culture in Taiwan - Summer Camp in NCUE**, During the camp we have hands-on DIY cultural courses, local tours to surrounding old towns, temples, and night market; and enterprise visiting about contemporary technology in Taiwan. A trip to the Formosan Aboriginal Culture Village and stay

overnight at Sun Moon Lake, the next day will attend a paper-making hands-on workshop in Puli Town. After the summer camp we will travel north to Taipei City, the Capital, and stay three nights to visit the National Palace Museum, Taipei 101 skyscraper, memorials, temples, YehLiu Geopark, and traditional night markets. Then we will fly to China and we will stay in Beijing and reside in Beijing Caixin Hotel on the Central University of Finance and Economics (CUFE) campus. During the 10-day stay, we will visit Tiananmen Square, the Forbidden City, the Summer Palace, Capital Museum, Beihai Park, Yonghe Lamasery, Temple of Confucius, Beijing Olympic Park, and watch an acrobatics show one evening. There will be a whole day trip to the Great Wall.
